ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF H.R. 763 – THE ENERGY INNOVATION AND CARBON DIVIDEND ACT OF 2019

WHEREAS, The City Council and our citizens value environmental stewardship and understand the urgency to reduce carbon emissions; and,

WHEREAS, Emissions of carbon pollution and other harmful pollutants into our Nation’s air impose substantial costs on all Americans and on future generations; and,

WHEREAS, Congress has introduced H.R. 763 – The Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act of 2019 to establish a carbon dividend and fee program to generate revenues in support of a program to encourage reduce carbon emissions, improve the environment and offset the negative impacts of global warming; and,

WHEREAS, As proposed, the program created by H.R. 763 would create more efficient markets, strengthen the U.S. Economy and benefit the Nation by encouraging competition, innovation and technological progress; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to register their official support of H.R. 763 – the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act of 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:


SECTION 1. The City Council hereby supports H.R. 763, also known as the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act of 2019.




